High School Senior Year CHECKLIST

Fall Semester (September-December)

- Discuss everything college with your parent /caregivers.
(Money, Transportation, Type of school, Instate out-of state).
- Attend the NYUL HBCU College Fair, in November at Riverbank State Park
(Get to know the Admission staff for the schools you are choosing)
- Seek the assistance of the New York Urban League's College Access Program
- Conduct Monthly visits with your school counselor to make sure you are on track to graduate and are able to fulfill college admission requirements.

- Schedule the SAT/ACT test and prepare by taking test prep courses in school or online.
- Participate in Extra Curricula, Co-Curricula, Community Service or Service Learning Projects.

Spring Semester (January-May)

- Visit college campuses to see what college is a fit for you.
- Apply for NYUL Whitney M. Young, Jr. Scholarship & Federal Student Aid (FASFA) on line at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- Apply to the schools of Your Choice (Schools have different deadlines).
- Keep track of and observe financial aid and admission deadlines.
- Decide which college to attend, and notify the school of your decision.
